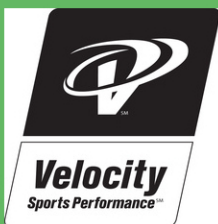

## **SPARQ**

The Pro Football Combine Camp features SPARQ training, protocols and ratings in conjunction with Velocity Sports Performance to help raise your level of athleticism and raise your game. Participants go through combine skills coaching, drills and testing to obtain actual combine scores, letting them know how they stack up against other athletes. SPARQ stands for Speed, Power, Agility, Reaction and Quickness. It offers dynamic performance training designed to make young athletes excel.

Campers must provide proof of health insurance to participate. Simply fill out the requested information regarding insurance carrier, policy or group number, and I.D. Send a copy of your insurance ID card with your registration and parental consent. A physical examination is not required prior to attending camp. If you have a known medical condition, we do advise you to check with your physician first. You **MUST** have your parents or legal guardian sign and submit the waiver/release from liability statement (included with application). Thibodaux Regional Medical Center is located adjacent to the NSU campus and can treat emergencies if need arises.
